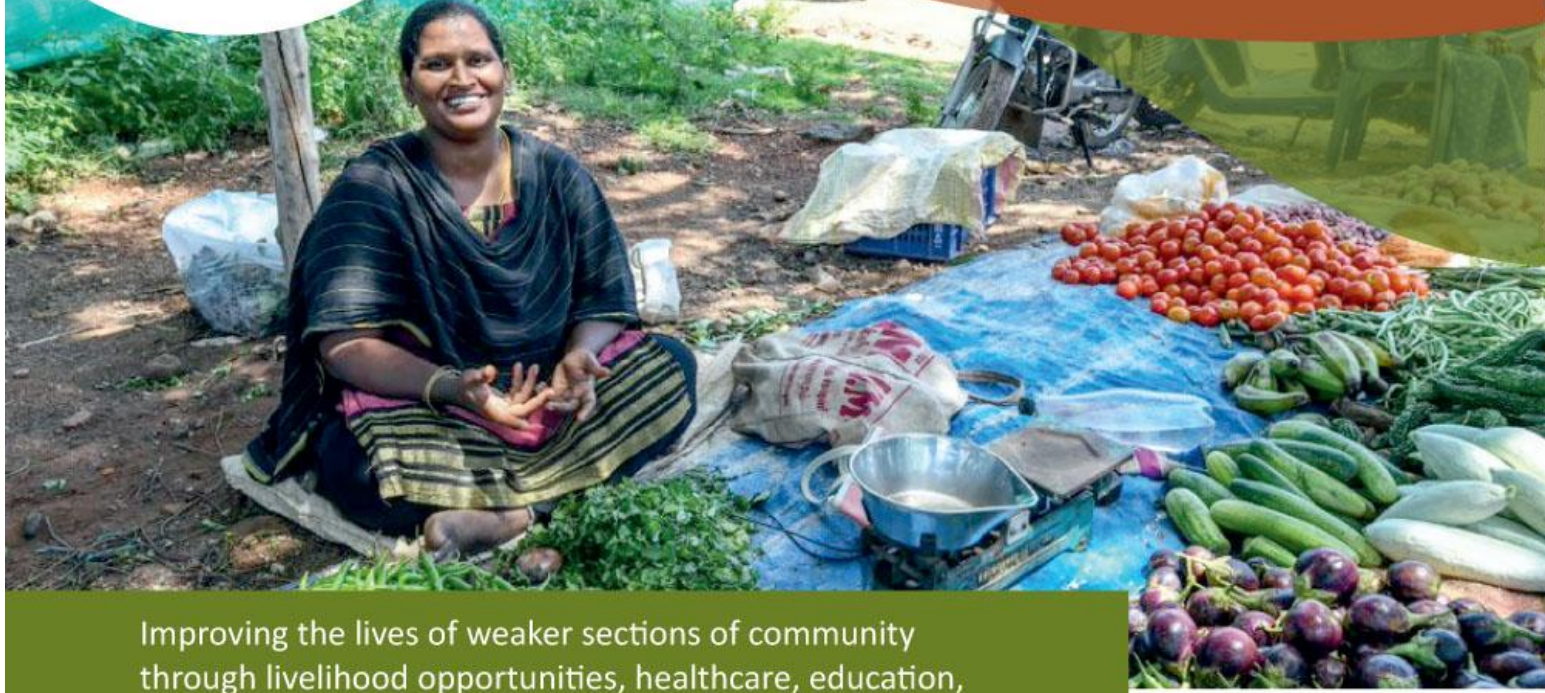

Improving the lives of weaker sections of community through livelihood opportunities, healthcare, education, advocacy, and environmental programmes

Organization overview

SINAM organisation's target is to address the caste discrimination issues prevailing in society, and strengthen the socio-economic conditions of youth, women, PWDs, and ST/SC communities to have equitable opportunities in society. We as an organization believe that education plays a vital role in enhancing the lives of a person, so we impart education to the children from undeserved communities, and run an evening coaching centre to facilitate their educational needs. Our interventions are focused on sustainable empowerment of marginalized communities, and lead a dignified life in society.

Problem statement

Tiruvanamalai district in Tamilnadu has some of the social evil practices embedded in it, and they are: child marriage, child labour, child abuse, and caste discrimination. On top of all that, nearly 75% of youth are unemployed, and 30% of SC/ST community live in absolute poverty - with no access to basic amenities, livelihood opportunities, education, and healthcare services. As far as women are concerned, they are subjected to domestic violence, gender inequality, and family problems that affect their overall well-being.

Our Approach



Family counselling

With the support of Central Social Welfare Board, we have a special family counselling centre opened for women to address domestic violence, marital maladjustments, dowry, economic crisis, harassment, depression, and suicide attempts. The first step is to identify target individuals through referrals, then we analyse their family history, provide counselling based on the issue, and follow up with them to ensure their welfare. We have been running this counselling centre for the past 10 years, and through this we also create awareness to SHGs, villages, government, and non-government institutions. Many people benefit through this initiative, and on average we reach 500 annually.

Education

Children from underprivileged communities drop out of schools, as their families migrate from their place to another. Very often, drop out children become a part of child labour system to support their families' financial needs. Under Supplementary Education programme, we nurture their educational needs and motivate children to pursue higher education. We work with these children for their comprehensive educational development - theoretical and practical approach, extracurricular activities, communication skills, dancing, and singing.

Women empowerment

It is important for women to have equal access to livelihood opportunities so that they can be an effective participator in community development. We form SHGs for women and provide them with access to education, skill training, income generation activities, and employment opportunities. Through this approach, many underprivileged women in Tiruvanmalai district have started their business and many became qualified for employment in mainstream society.

Environment

In order to improve the environmental condition, we plant many saplings each year to counteract the number of trees that are destroyed for modernization. Under "Pasumai Anganwadi Centre" programme, we plant saplings around anganwadis, and hospitals to increase clean air and O2 level. Apart from that, we build eco-friendly houses, eco-friendly toilets, and solar energy to mitigate the global warming effects.

Skill development

Youths and People with disabilities are denied job opportunities due to lack of vocational skills. We provide skill training programmes and rehabilitation services for youths as well as for people with disabilities, which has enabled many to be entrepreneurs and placed many in different jobs in mainstream society.
